Aeroplane Landing Area (ALA) Training

Our one-day ALA course is an abridged version of our full Aerodrome Reporting Officer course. This course specifically relates to the aspects of inspecting an Aeroplane Landing Area (ALA) and the general operation of these aerodromes.

The course focuses on the advice provided by the Civil Aviation Advisory Publication (CAAP) 92-1 and best practice suggestions for this category of aerodrome, where AROs are not required to be present. Whilst training for the operation of ALAs is not mandated, this course provides valuable introductory knowledge and skills that support the ALA operations and enhances aerodrome safety for those wishing to go beyond the minimum requirements.
